2018 USE OF FORCE REVIEW

The Tiverton Police Department recorded six (6) use of force incidents between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.

Of the six use of force incidents, six resulted in an arrest. The Tiverton Police Department recorded 494 Arrests in 2018. Of these arrests, 289 persons were taken into custody as opposed to being summonsed into court. Use of force had been used on 2.07% of persons taken into custody by the Tiverton Police Department.
